EXERCISE OF POWERS OF THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

THE NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 149 (4) of the Constitution and all other powers it enabling, hereby determine that the powers, functions, duties and responsibilities of the National Executive Council in advising the Head of State to execute contracts of employment for persons whose appointment is made by the National Executive Council shall be exercised by the Minister for Public Service by instrument in the name of the National Executive Council.

CONSTITUTION

DETERMINATION OF TEMPORARY RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTER

- I, Julius Chan, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, hereby determine—
 - (a) that the Minister for Commerce and Industry shall have the responsibilities of the Minister for Agriculture and Livestock; and
 - (b) that the Minister for Transport shall have the responsibilities of the Minister for Civil Aviation; and
 - (c) that the Minister for Higher Education, Science and Technology shall have the responsibilities of the Minister for Labour and Employment and of the Minister for Public Service; and
 - (d) that the Prime Minister shall have the responsibilities of the Minister for Communication,

for a period commencing on and from 13th July, 1995 until further notice.
