CONSTITUTION

DIRECTION TO THE PUBLIC PROSECUTOR

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 176(3)(b) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby give to the Public Prosecutor the following directions:—

- 1. The Public Prosecutor shall—
 - (a) not initiate a prosecution; or
 - (b) where a prosecution has been initiated, shall immediately discontinue the prosecution,

of a person for an offence where—

- (c) the offence was committed or is alleged to have been committed in relation to the Bougainville crisis between 1st October, 1988 and 19th May, 1995—
 - (i) in Bougainville Province; and
 - (ii) outside Bougainville Province; and
- (d) the offence was committed or is alleged to have been committed by a person other than a non-citizen whose presence in the country at the time of commission or alleged commission of the offence was illegal.
- 2. The exception referred to in Direction I(d) shall not apply to a non-citizen who, by reason of the Bougainville crisis, was unable to renew a visa.
