SPECIFIED CURRENCY

THE BANK OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA, by virtue of the powers conferred on it by the *Central Banking Act* and the Central Banking (Foreign Exchange and Gold) Regulation (the "Regulation") hereby orders that each and every foreign currency is declared to be a specified foreign currency for the purposes of Section 12 of the Regulation. This Order shall remain in force until it is revoked.

The Bank hereby consents to the retention and use of any foreign currency:—

- (a) held by or on behalf of any person resident in Papua New Guinea pursuant to any mining development contract or petroleum agreement;
- (b) held by or on behalf of any person resident in Papua New Guinea pursuant to any act of Parliament;
- (c) held by or on behalf of any person resident in Papua New Guinea pursuant to an existing authority or exemption under the Regulation;
- (d) acquired by any natural person resident in Papua New Guinea before such person became resident in Papua New Guinea;
- (e) derived outside Papua New Guinea by any natural person from personal exertion;

Specified Currency-continued

- (f) derived outside Papua New Guinea by any natural person without consideration including by way of gift, lottery, inheritance or windfall gain:
- (g) remitted from Papua New Guinea by any natural person pursuant to the authority given by Exchange Notice No. 20 or otherwise pursuant to any authority or approval granted by the Central Bank or any authorised dealer;
- (h) retained by any person in a foreign currency account (whether within or outside Papua New Guinea) with the authority or approval of the Central Bank; or
- (i) derived by any natural person from a sale, tranfer assignment, lease or other form of dealing with any asset outside Papua New Guinea where such asset was acquired:
 - (i) before the person became resident in Papua New Guinea; or

- (ii) after the person became resident in Papua New Guinea but using foreign currency which the person is permitted to use (or would now be permitted to use) because it falls under any of the precoding paragraphs (d) to (h) inclusive.
- Note:—By Section 12 of the Regulation, every person in Papua New Guinea, other than the Bank of Papua New Guinea or an authorised dealer, who owns or is entitled to sell or procure the sale of any specified currency must offer, or cause to be offered, the specified currency for sale to the Bank of Papua New Guinea unless:
 - (a) the Bank of Papua New Guinea consents to his intention or use of it; or
 - (b) he disposes of it to any other person with the authority of the Bank of Papua New Guinea.
