REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONER OF POLICE AND DEPARTMENTAL HEAD OF THE DEPARTMENT OF POLICE

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(2) and (3) of the Constitution, Section 6 of the *Police Force Act* (Chapter 65) and Section 27 of the *Public Service* (Management) Act 1995 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public Services Commission and the Permanent Parliamentary Committee on Appointments, hereby—

- (a) revoke the appointment of Henry Tokam as Commissioner of Police and Departmental Head of Police; and
- (b) promote and appoint Bob Nenta to be the Commissioner of Police and the Departmental Head of the Department of Police,

with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the National Gazette.

## REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND PROMOTION AND APPOINTMENT OF DEPUTY COMMISSIONERS OF POLICE

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 35 of the *Police Force Act* (Chapter 65) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby—

(a revoke the appointment of Bob Nenta as Deputy Commissioner of Police; and

(b) revoke the appointment of Graham Ainui as Deputy Commissioner of Police; and

(c) promote and appoint Ludwig Kembu to the rank of Deputy Commissioner (Operations) of Police,

(d) promote and appoint Gamini Ora to the rank of Deputy Commissioner (Administration) of Police,

with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the National Gazette.
