Customs Act (Chapter 101) of the Revised Laws of Papua New Guinea

## EXEMPTION

I, Chris Haiveta, Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Finance, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 1.A of the *Customs Act* (Chapter 101) of the Revised Laws of Papua New Guinea, and all other powers it enabling, hereby grant Ilimo Poultry Products Pty Ltd a company duly incorporated in Papua New Guinea the following exemptions effective as of 3rd September, 1996.

- (a) that Ilimo be exempted from the 11% duty on imported feeds, grains and related raw materials; and
- (b) that Ilimo be exempted from the duty on capital items for the construction of the processing facility; and
- (c) that Ilimo be exempted from the current K3.65/Kg tariff on the imported frozen birds to meet market demand.

The exemptions are for a special purpose and once-off case for a period of twelve months to enable Ilimo to bring its production to normal.
