Citizenship Act (Chapter 12)

### REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN AND PERMANENT MEMBERS OF THE CITIZENSHIP ADVISORY COMMITTEE

I, Wiwa Korowi, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 75 of the Constitution and10(3) of the *Citizenship Act* (Chapter 12) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Permanent Parliamentary Committee hereby—

- (a) revoke all previous appointments of members, Chairman and Deputy Chairman of the Citizenship Advisory Committee: and
- (b) re-appoint Ginson Saonu, a member of the Parliament, to be a permanent member and Chairman of the Citizenship Advisory Committee: and
- (c) re-appoint Mathias Karani, a member of the Parliament, to be a permanent member and Deputy Chairman of the Citizenship Advisory Committee: and
- (d) re-appoint Veali Vagi and Sao Gabi to be members of the Citizenship Advisory Committee.
