EXEMPTION FROM AND REDUCTION OF IMPORT DUTIES IN RESPECT OF CERTAIN GOODS IMPORTED FROM THE REPUBLIC OF FUI

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(b) of the *Customs Tariff Act* 1990 and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby, with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the National Gazette reduce to the duty rate specified in the Schedule the import duty on goods specified in the Schedule,

where such goods-

.

- (a) are imported from the Republic of Fiji; and
- (b) originate in the country from which they are imported in accordance with the Rules of Origin set out in Annex 1 to Schedule 1 to the Trade Agreement between the Republic of Fiji and the Independent State of Papua New Guinea.

(a) Front: The background tints surrounding the national crest on the front of the note depicts the National Parliament Building featuring patterns taken from: a cance from the Milne Bay Province, Sepik spears, a Madang shield, a bowl from the Highlands.

The design of the Bank of Papua New Guinea Silver Jubilee Logo in blue print against a silver background and the legend, Bank of Papua New Guinea Silver Jubilee, 1973 - 1998 appears on the left side of the national crest and below the numeral "10".

- (b) Back: The back of this note features five main items: a Tami bowl, a Bird of Paradise skin, Tambu shell money from New Britain, boar tusks from the Highlands and the National Parliament Building featuring patterns taken from a Gulf shield, a ceremonial dance paddle from Bougainville, a Sepik clay pot, a Gulf bark belt and marriage bed from the Manus Province.
- (c) Common features: This special Bank of Papua New Guinea Silver Jubilee commemorative K10.00 banknote is produced on paper substrate and has common security features as the existing K10.00 banknotes bearing the transparent water mark of the Bank of Papua New Guinea logo on the right hand side and the metal security thread running through the note on the left hand side of the front of the note.
