APPROVED LAE CITY ROUTES

THE NATIONAL TRANSPORT BOARD, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 60(1) of the Motor Traffic Regulation (Chapter 243), hereby approved the following routes within the City of Lae as specified in the Schedule:-
