MADE by the National Parliament, to be deemed to have come into operation on 1st January, 1998.

1. INTERPRETATION OF SCHEDULES 1 TO 6 (AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE 1).

Schedule 1.1 of the Organic Law on Provincial Governments and Local-level Governments is amended by repealing the definition of "maritime provinces" and replacing it with the following:—

" 'maritime provinces' shall be the provinces of Manus, New Ireland, West New Britain, East New Britain, Milne Bay and Bougainville;".
