Prime Minister's Act (Chapter 27)

REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF ACTING PRIME MINISTER

I, John Pundari, MP., Acting Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 143(1) of the Constitution and Section 3(2) of the *Prime Minister's Act* (Chapter 27), and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby:—

- (a) revoke all the previous appointments of acting Prime Minister; and
- (b) appoint Iairo Lasaro, a Minister to be the Acting Prime Minister for the period commencing on and from 3rd June, 1998 up until 11th June, 1998 while both the Prime Minister and the Deputy Prime Minister are overseas.

Broadcasting Corporation Act (Chapter 149)

REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT OF MANAGING DIRECTOR AND DEPUTY MANAGING DIRECTOR AND APPOINTMENT OF MANAGING DIRECTOR OF THE NATIONAL BROADCASTING CORPORATION
