*Customs Tariff Act 1990***REDUCED RATE OF IMPORT DUTY**

I, Silas Atopare, G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(b) of the *Customs Tariff Act 1990* and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby reduce, with effect from the date of publication in the *National Gazette*, to 10.00% the rate of import duty payable on all items specified in Schedule 2 which but for this reduction would have attracted a higher rate of import duty, based on the average of the total of the import and excise duties payable on the items specified in Column 2 of Schedule 1.

 - (b) is specifically, or has been generally, certified by the Secretary, Department of Mineral Resources to have a specialized application and is specifically designed for technical use in mining operations.
2. Plant, machinery, equipment, temporary buildings and structures, vehicles, explosives, fuels, reagents, supplies or other assets, any one of which, at the time when such duty is sought to be imposed is imported by Misima Mines Pty Ltd, solely for the purpose of mining operations or operations connected therewith.
3. Plant, machinery, equipment, temporary buildings and structures, vehicles, explosives, fuels, reagents, supplies or other assets, any of which, at the time when such duty is sought to be imposed—
 - (a) is imported solely for the purpose of the Lihir Gold Mine, Lihir Island, New Ireland Province; and
 - (b) is specifically, or has been generally, certified by the Secretary, Department of Mineral Resources to have a specialized application and is specifically designed for technical use in mining operations.
4. Plant, machinery, equipment, explosives, vehicles, chemicals, fuels, supplies or other assets, any of which, at the time when such duty is sought to be imposed—
 - (a) is imported solely for the purpose implementing the Kutubu Petroleum Project; and
 - (b) is specifically, or has been generally, certified by the Secretary, Department of Petroleum and Energy to have a specialized application and is specifically designed for technical use in Petroleum operations.
