#### CONSTITUTION

#### DETERMINATION OF TEMPORARY RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

- I, Sir Mekere Morauta, Prime Minister, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 148 of the Constitution, and all other powers me enabling, hereby determine that:—
  - (a) the Minister for Correctional Services shall have the responsibilities of the Labour and Employment portfolio; and
  - (b) the Prime Minister shall have the responsibilities of the Corporatisation and Privatisation portfolio; and
  - (c) the Minister for Public Service shall have the responsibilities of the Provincial and Local-level Governments portfolio; and
  - (d) the Minister for Lands and Physical Planning shall have the responsibilities of the Petroleum and Energy portfolio; and
  - (e) the Deputy Prime Minister and Minister for Agriculture and Livestock shall have the responsibilities of the Home Affairs portfolio,

with effect from March, 2000 until further notice.

## AMENDMENT OF DETERMINATION OF TITLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES OF MINISTERS

  - (b) in Schedule 6, in Column 1, by deleting the name "Daniel Kapi" and replacing it with the following:—
    "Andrew Kumbakor"; and
  - (c) in Schedule 15, in Column 1, by deleting the name "Sir Mekere Morauta"; and
  - (d) in Schedule 18, in Column 1, by deleting the name "Chris Haiveta"; and
  - (e) in Schedule 21, in Column 1, by deleting the name "Tommy Tomscoll"; and
  - (f) in Schedule 24, in Column 1, by deleting the name "Andrew Kumbakor"; and
  - (g) by adding the following new Schedule:—
