#### **DECLARATION UNDER SECTION 133**

I, Morris Alaluku, A delegate of the Minister for Lands, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 133 of the Land Act (Chapter 1996), and all other powers me enabling, hereby declare that the land referred to in the Schedule is customary land.

#### SCHEDULE
