SCHEDULE

FUNCTIONS OF DEPARTMENT OF PLANNING & IMPLEMENTATION

The Department of Planning and Implementation will have the following functions:—

- 1. Formulate national development plans, policies and strategies for medium and long term development of the nation with objectives of achieving national unity, basic education and primary health care for all, and opportunities for earning income and employment.
- 2. Manage and co-ordinate preparation and implementation of all development programmes and projects and relevant policies to ensure that national development objectives and targets are achieved.
- 3. Develop, prepare and manage the rolling 5-year National Development Plan (including a Public Asset/Infrastructure Maintenance Programme) and Budget and ensure the annual budget appropriations at all levels of government support the Development and Maintenance programme.
- 4. Develop, implement and manage the national planning and implementation system including an appropriate information and data system, at the national, provincial and district levels in close co-operation with all agencies and levels of government, the private sector, churches and NGO's.
- 5. Manage and co-ordinate all international development assistance to Papua New Guinea and to ensure that international assistance achieves national development objectives.
- 6. Provide technical assistance and other relevant support and training to agencies and provinces, districts including churches and NGO's in relation to the above functions.
- 7. Prepare and provide regular reports to the National Executive Council and National Parliament on the development status of the nation and on implementation of development plans, policies and programmes.
