REVOCATION AND APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN, DEPUTY CHAIRMAN, MEMBERS AND ALTERNATE MEMBERS OF THE INDUSTRIAL CENTRES DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION BOARD

I, Hon. John Tekwie, Minister for Trade and Industry, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 9, 10 and 11 of the Industrial Centres Development Corporation Act 1990 and all other powers me enabling, hereby

- revoke the appointment of each person specified in Column 1 of Schedule 1, to cease to be a member and alternate member of the Industrial Centres Development Corporation Board, appointed under the respective provisions specified in Column 2 of the Schedule opposite his name; and
- revoke the appointment of Joseph Mand, as Chairman of the Industrial Centres Development Corporation Board; and
- appoint each person specified in Column 1 of Schedule 2 to be member of the Industrial Centres Development Corporation Board, appointed under the respective provision specified in Column 2 of the Schedule opposite his name and each person specified under Column 3 of the Schedule to be the Alternate member of the Board for the member opposite his name for a period of two years; and
- appoint Dr Sylvester Lahe to be Chairman of the Industrial Centres Development Corporation Board for a period of two years,

with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the National Gazette.
