## **DECLARATION OF TOWN OF LORENGAU**

I, Rt. Hon. Sir Michael Thomas Somare, GCMG, KStJ., CH., Prime Minister and Minister for State Enterprises and Information, by virtue of the powers conferred by the *National Water Supply and Sewerage Act* 1986 and all other powers me enabling, hereby declare the area described in the Schedule hereto and as amended from time to time, to be the Town of Lorengau in Manus Province for the purposes of that Act.

### SCHEDULE

All that piece or parcel of land containing an area of 945 hectares or thereabouts of which approximately 78 hectares is below the high water mark of Seeadler Harbour situated in the Milinch of Kelaua, Fourmil of Los Negros, Manus Province commencing at a point bearing 4 degrees 21 minutes 30 seconds for 117 metres from the northwestern corner of Allotment 22 of Section 35 in the Town of Lorengau in the said Milinch and bounded thence generally on the north-east by a line parallel to and distant 100.58 metres from the said high water mark of Seeadler Harbour generally south-easterly for approximately 3505 metres to its intersection with the northerly prolongation of the eastern boundary of Portion 66 by a straight line bearing 184 degrees 24 minutes for 100.58 metres to the aforesaid high water mark of Seeadler Harbour to the north-eastern corner of the said Portion 66 thence bounded again on the east by the eastern boundaries of Portions 66, 67, 68 and 71 in the said Milinch by straight lines bearing 184 degrees 24 minutes for 910.69 metres and 184 degrees 25 minutes for 186.66 metres to the south-eastern corner of Portion 71 aforesaid thence bounded on the south by the southern boundaries of Portions 76 and 77 in the said Milinch by straight lines bearing 274 degrees 23 minutes for 272.52 metres, 274 degrees 23 minutes 30 seconds for 266.35 metres and 274 degrees 23 minutes for 228.89 metres, thence bounded again on the east by the eastern boundaries of Portions 74, 75 and 76 in the said Milinch by straight lines bearing 186 degrees 28 minutes 30 seconds for 265.50 metres and 186 degrees 28 minutes for 411.21 metres to the south-eastern corner of Portion 76 aforesaid thence bounded on the south by the southern boundaries of Portions 76 and 77 in the said Milinch by straight lines bearing 280 degrees 12 minutes 30 seconds for 176.73 metres and 274 degrees 24 minutes for 510.76 metres to the south-eastern corner of Portion 77 aforesaid thence bounded on the south-west by the south-eastern boundaries of Portions 21 and 21A in the said Milinch by straight lines bearing 305 degrees 14 minutes for 1219.91 metres to the south-western corner of the said Portion 20A thence bounded generally on the south-west by several straight lines bearing 304 degrees 38 minutes 30 seconds for 121.71 metres, 308 degrees 25 minutes 10 seconds for 2217.69 metres, 300 degrees 50 minutes 20 seconds for 249.94 metres, 347 degrees 42 minutes for 533.77 metres, 343 degrees 38 minutes 10 seconds for 441.85 metres, 348 degrees 27 minutes for 1024 metres to the high water mark of Seeadler Harbour aforesaid thence bounded again on the south-west by the prolongation of the said line bearing 348 degrees 27 minutes for 100.58 metres to a point in the said Seeadler Harbour thence bounded by a line parallel to and distant 100.58 metres, from the said high water mark of Seeadler Harbour generally south-east for approximately 3780 metres to the point of commencement be the said several dimensions all a little more or less and all bearings Fourmil Standard.

Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership

## **REFERRAL OF A LEADER FOR PROSECUTION**

THE OMBUDSMAN COMMISSION, having investigated suspected misconduct in office by Dr Puka Temu CMG, MP., member for Abau Open and member of the Central Provincial Assembly and Minister for Lands and Physical Plannning, he being a person to whom Division III.2 of the Constitution and the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership apply, having granted that person a right to be heard and having deliberated on the matter, hereby gives notice that it has determined in its deliberate judgement pursuant to Section 29(1) of the Constitution and Sections 17(d), 20(4) and 27(1)(a) of the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership:

- (a)that there is a prima facie case that the person has been guilty of misconduct in office; and
- **(b)** that the matteer has been referred to the Public Prosecutor and if he decides to prosecutor the matter, he shall so prosecute before an independent leadership tribunal established under Section 28(1)(g) of the Constitution and Section 27(7) of the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership; and
- that the matter referred relates to the leader's failure to submit his four annual statements as required under *(c)* Section 4 of the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership.

## **REFERRAL OF A LEADER FOR PROSECUTION**

THE OMBUDSMAN COMMISSION, having investigated alleged misconduct in office by Ano Pala, Clerk of the National Parliament, he being a person to whom Division III.2 (Leadership Code ) of the Constitution and the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership apply, having granted that person a right to be heard and having deliberated on the matter, hereby gives notice that it has determined in its deliberate judgement pursuant to Section 29(1) of the Constitution and Sections 17(d), 20(4) and 27(1)(a) of the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership:

- (a) that there is a prima facie case that the person has been guilty of misconduct in office; and
- *(b)* that the matter has been referred to the Public Prosecutor and if he decides to prosecutor the matter, he shall so prosecute before an independent leadership tribunal established under Section 28(1)(g) of the Constitution and Section 27(7)(c) of the Organic Law on the Duties and Responsibilities of Leadership; and
- that the matter referred relates to the leader's alleged failure on two occasions to properly and competently (*C*) conduct and supervise the election by the Parliament for the post of Governor-General thus giving rise to the integrity of the National Parliament and Office of Clerk being brought into question here in Papua New Guinea and abroad.
