## DECLARATION OF PUBLIC PLACE

- I, Peter Barter, Minister for Inter-Government Relations, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 4 of the Liquor (Miscellaneous Provisions) Act (Chapter 313), and all other powers me enabling, in consultation with the Liquor Licensing Commission, hereby:—
  - (a) declare the Portion of Land known as the Kakaruk Market in the town of Goroka, Eastern Highlands Province, to be a public place; and
  - (b) restrict the disposal and consumption of alcohol at the above declared public place, with effect on and from the date of publication of this notice in the *National Gazette*.
