DEPLOYMENT OF ADDITIONAL POLICE RPNGC PERSONNEL ON REGIONAL ASSISTANCE MISSION SOLOMON ISLANDS

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 197(4) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after the approval of the Parliament, hereby ordered, a part of the Police Force (25 Officers), for international peace-keeping operation to Solomon Islands (RAMSI) with effect on and from 20th April, 2006.

CALL-OUT IN AID TO THE CIVIL POWER

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 204(1) of the Constitution and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby call out the Defence Force to provide assistance to civilian authorities for security operations in support of the maintenance of law and order throughout Papua New Guinea for the duration of the following five National Events:—

- (a) ACP-EU Summit 2006, NCD; and
- (b) NCD Regional Seat By-Elections; and
- (c) Koroba-Lake Kopiago By-Elections; and
- (d) International Coroner's Conference, NCD; and
- (e) National Elections 2007, Special Operations,

with effect on and from 26th May, 2006 up until the end of the 2007 National Elections.
