### DECLARATION OF NOTIFIABLE ANIMAL DISEASES

I, Sasa Zibe, Minister for Agriculture and Livestock, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 7(1) of the Animal Disease and Control Act (Chapter 206) and all other powers me enabling, hereby:—

- (a) revoke all previous notices of declaration of notifiable animal diseases; and
- (b) declare the following list of animal diseases as notifiable for the purpose of the Act:—

Highly pathogenic avian influenza (HPAI) Virulent Newcastle Disease Classic swine fever (Hog Cholera) Transmissible gastroenteritis Aujeszky's disease Foot and Mouth Disease Boophilus microplus (Cattle tick) Rinderpest Bovine spongiform encephalitis Rabies
