### EXEMPTION FROM IMPORT DUTY AND EXEMPTION FROM GOODS AND SERVICES TAX

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 9(1)(a) of the Customs Tariff Act 1990 and Section 25(8) of the Goods and Services Tax Act 2003, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby, exempt from import duty and goods and services tax on the importation of motor vehicles, building materials and other goods directly purchased or contributed towards the ACP and ACP/EU Joint Ministers Meeting for the period commencing on and from 1st January, 2006 up to and including 30th June, 2006.

#### APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONERS AND ALTERNATE COMMISSIONERS

  - (a) each person specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to be a Commissioner of Higher Education to represent the institution specified opposite in Column 3; and
  - (b) each person specified in Column 2 of the Schedule to be an alternate Commissioner of Higher Education for the Commissioner shown opposite in column 1,

for a period of three years commencing on and from 27th January, 2006.
