Citizenship Act (Chapter 12)

TERMINATION OF APPOINTMENTS AND APPOINTMENT OF CHAIRMAN AND DEPUTY CHAIRMAN OF THE CITIZENSHIP ADVISORY COMMITTEE

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 75 of the Constitution and Section 10(3) of the *Citizenship Act* (Chapter 12) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Permanent Parliamentary Committee, hereby:—

- (a) terminate the appointments of Guao Zurenuoc, a member of the Parliament, as a permanent member and Chairman of the Citizenship Advisory Committee and Martin Aini, a member of the Parliament, as a permanent member and Deputy Chairman of the Citizenship Advisory Committee; and
- (b) terminate the appointment of Francis Damem as a permanent member of the Citizenship Advisory Committee; and
- (c) appoint Dr Banare Bun, a member of the Parliament, to be a permanent member and Chairman of the Citizenship Advisory Committee; and
- (d) appoint Cecilking Doruba, a member of the Parliament, to be a permanent member and Deputy Chairman of the Citizenship Advisory Committee; and
- (e) appoint Secretary for Foreign Affairs and Immigration, ex-officio; and
- (f) appoint Secretary for Justice and Attorney-General, ex-officio,

with effect on and from the date of publication of this notice in the National Gazette.
