EXTENSION OF TIME FOR RETURNING THE WRITS FOR ELECTION OF MEMBERS OF THE NATIONAL PARLIAMENT

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers vested in me by Section 177 of the Organic Law on National and Local-level Government Elections and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the Electoral Commission (being of the opinion that it is necessary to do so to prevent a difficulty which might otherwise interfere with the due course of the elections of Members of the National Parliament in each electorate, the date for the return of the writs for which is on or before the 30th July, 2007) hereby extend the date for the return of writs until 6th August, 2007 the date on which writs for the said elections shall be returned.
