Prices Regulation Act (Chapter 320)

# WATER AND SEWERAGE SERVICES PRICES ORDER 2008

MADE by the Independent Consumer and Competition Commission under Section 21 of the *Prices Regulation Act* (Chapter 320) to come into effect from 1st January, 2008.

The Water and Sewerage Services Prices Order 2007 is amended by repealing Schedule 1 to that Order and replacing it with the following Schedule:

### SCHEDULE I

This Schedule relates to the maximum Water and Sewerage rates for all Water Supply and Sewerage Services supplied by PNG Water Board. The maximum prices which may be charged by PNG Water Board in respect of any accounts issued on or after 1st January, 2008 (other than arrears, which may only be charged at the maximum prices prevailing when those charges were incurred) are as follows:
