## APPOINTMENT OF MINIMUM WAGES BOARD MEMBERS

I, Grand Chief Sir Paulias Matane, Governor-General, G.C.L., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 10 of the *Industrial Relations Act* (Chapter 174) and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, hereby:----

- (a) appoint Bill Sharp Kua as member of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the Government; and
- (b) appoint John Gordon Jeffrey and Allan Philip Maino as members of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the Employers' Federation of Papua New Guinea; and
- (c) appoint Reginald McAlister and Clemence Kanau as members of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the PNG Maritime Workers' Union; and
- (d) appoint Scholla Warai Kakas as member of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the community affairs; and
- (e) appoint Bishop Oika Gabutu as member of the Minimum Wages Board to represent the Churches,

with effect on and from the date of publication of this instrument in the National Gazette.
