Public Services (Management) Act 1995

REVOCATION OF ACTING APPOINTMENT, SECRETARY AND APPOINTMENT OF SECRETARY OF THE DEPARTMENT OF PRIME MINISTER AND NATIONAL EXECUTIVE COUNCIL

I, SIR MICHAEL OGIO., G.C.M.G., K.St.J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 193(1A) and (1C) of the Constitution, and Sections 31A and 31C of the *Public Services (Management) Act 1995*, and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public Services Commission, hereby —

- (a) revoke the appointment of Margaret Elias as —
 - (i) acting Secretary for the Department of Prime Minister and National Executive Council published in the *National Gazette* No. G117 of 12th June, 2009; and
 - (ii) as Secretary for the Department of Prime Minister and National Executive Council published in the *National Gazette* No. G70 of 18th March, 2011; and
- (b) revoke the appointment of Manasupe Zurenuoc as Secretary of the Department of Prime Minister and National Executive Council published in the *National Gazette* No. G41 of 11th March, 2008; and
- (c) appoint Manasupe Zurenuoc as Secretary for the Department of Prime Minister and National Executive Council for a period of four (4) years, commencing on and from 11th August, 2011.
