APPOINTMENT OF SECTION 32 OFFICER

I, Steven Gibson, Acting Secretary of Finance, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 32(1) of the *Public Finances (Management) Act 1995* and by all powers enabling me, hereby:

- (a) Revoked Section 32 financial powers formerly held by Secretary for National Planning and Monitoring to approve requisitions for development funds in the Public Investment Program.
- (b) Approved the appointment of Paul Sai'i acting Secretary for the new Department of Implementation and Rural Development to approve requisitions for expenditure of moneys with a warrant authority for a purpose specified, to come into effect on and from the date of the publication of this instrument for the Department of Implementation and Rural Development in the *National Gazette*.
- (c) Declare that the Section 32 power to approve expenditure under Public Investment Program funds formerly administered by Department of National Planning is now withdrawn.
- (d) Acting Secretary for the new Department of Implementation and Rural Development will only become a mandatory signatory to all trust accounts, as the management of trust accounts will remain with Finance Department.

This appointment is effective as at 31st August, 2011.
