*Ports (Management and Safety) Regulation 2010***PORTS SAFETY DIRECTIONS**

THE NATIONAL MARTIME SAFETY AUTHORITY, by virtue of the powers conferred by Sections 13 and 14 of the Ports (Management and Safety) Regulation 2010, and all other powers it enabling hereby issues the following Ports Safety Directions:—

- (a) all vessels calling into Kieta Port to enter and exit during day light hours only from 6am to 4pm; and

Ports Safety Directions—continued

- (b) all vessels calling into Kieta Port should be equipped with appropriate charts, GPS, Radar etc., essential for the proper navigation of the passageway; and
(c) all Masters and Pilots bringing in vessels to berth at the Kieta Wharf refrain from doing so on overcast days and when visibility of the area is unfavourable.
