TAKE NOTICE, that at the expiration of 14 days from the date of publication of this notice, University of Natural Resources and Environment (UNRE), your partner in the Joint Venture in the enterprise known as Gunter Balsa Limited, intends to seize the assets of the company. The purpose of this exercise is to recover the large amount of debt and damages owed to the University which, in spite of repeated approaches, have not been settled until your sudden and immediate departure from PNG (East New Britain Province) without notice.
