CONSTITUTION

- (b) determine that each Minister set out in Column 1 of each Schedule shall have
 - the title specified in Column 2; and (i)
 - (ii) the responsibilities specified in Column 3; and
 - (iii) the responsibilities for administering the Acts (or parts of the Act) specified in Column 4, and set out opposite the name of the Minister,

to come into effect on and from the date of signature of this instrument.
