Defence Act (Chapter 74)

REVOCATION OF APPOINTMENT AND APPOINTMENT OF COMMANDER OF PAPUA NEW GUINEA DEFENCE FORCE

I, GRAND CHIEF SIR MICHAEL OGIO, GCL., G.C.M.G., K. St. J., Governor-General, by virtue of the powers conferred by Section 193(3) of the Constitution and Section 6(1) of the Defence Act (Charpter 74), and all other powers me enabling, acting with, and in accordance with, the advice of the National Executive Council, given after consultation with the Public Services Commission, hereby—

- (a) revoke the appointment of GENERAL GILBERT TOROPO as Commander of the Papua New Guinea Defence Force for the purpose of rectifying the appointment made without complying with provisons of Section 193 of the Constitution in Decision No. 01/2014; and
- (b) appoint GENERAL GILBERT TOROPO as Commander of the Papua New Guinea Defence Force, for a period of four (4) years.
