ORDER

The Court orders that:

- Upon hearing of this petition and upon proof, satisfactory to the Court of the debt of the Petitioner and the
 act of insolvency alleged to have been committed by the Respondent, it is ordered that Yii Ann Hii be and
 is adjudged insolvent.
- 2. For the purposes of Section 49(a) of the *Insolvency Act*, the date for the first general meeting of Creditors of the Respondent, for the election of a Trustee is fixed as 10:00 am on 11th September, 2017 and the place shall be the office of the Registrar of this National Court at Waigani.
- 3. For the purposes of Section 49(b) of the Insolvency Act, the time shall be 10:00 am on 8th September, 2017 and the place shall be the office of the Registrar of this National Court at Waigani, and the Debtor is ordered to comply with Section 49(b) of the Insolvency Act by delivering to the Trustee a full, true and accurate statement, verified on oath of his debts and liabilities of every kind and of the name and residences as far as they are known to him of his creditors and the causes of his inabilities to meet his engagements.

- 4. That the costs of and expenses of and incidential to this Petition be taxed and repaid to the Petitioner out of the first monies received from the estate of the Respondent pursuant to Section 37(3) of the *Insolvency Act*.
- 5. This Order is to be published once in the *National Gazette* and twice in the Post Courier Newspapers at least 7 days before the first meeting of the creditors.
- 6. The time for the entry of this order is abridged to the time of settlement by the Registrar which shall take place forthwith.
