EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) REGULATIONS 2020

EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (RESTRICTIONS OF MOVEMENT OF SMALL CRAFT VESSELS) (SOLOMON ISLANDS AND PAPUA NEW GUINEA BORDER) ORDER 2020

I, Hon. Manasseh D. Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 14(1) of the Emergency Powers (COVID-19) Regulations 2020, make the following order;

1. Citation

This order may be cited as the Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Restrictions of Movement of Small Craft Vessels) (Solomon Islands and Papua New Guinea Border) order 2020.

2. Commencement

This order commence on the date it is published in the Gazette.

3. Definitions

"border" means the border shared by Solomon Islands and Papua New Guinea and demarcated by red lines on the map in the schedule;

"small craft vessel" means a vessel that is not more than 10 metres long.


4. Restrictions of movement of small craft vessels

A small craft vessel must not:

- (a) Leave Solomon Islands by crossing the border; or
- (b) Enter Solomon Islands by crossing the border; or
- (c) If the small craft vessel enters Solomon Islands by crossing the border, must not remain in Solomon Islands but must immediately leave Solomon Islands by moving back across the border.
