BERNARD GIRO, MP Minister for Home Affairs 9. Powers of **(1)** A Health Inspector may -Enter and inspect at any reasonable time, any entry and premises and or the market place which the Health inspection

Inspector reasonably believe any article used in the handling, displaying, packing or storing, and or serving of food for sale;

(b) Seize any food as prescribe other than those in Schedule 2 of the Market Ordinance.

10. In the performance of an inspection under section 9, a Health Seizure and Inspector may seize any food or article that is or appears to him to be:-

condemnation of food unfit for human

consumption

- (a) dangerous
- (b) injurious
- (c) unfit for use
- (d) unwholesome; or
- (e) otherwise adulterated or falsely described, as evidence that an offence against the Ordinance is being or has been committed.
- 11. Subject to the provisions of this section, any person who offer for sale, any food or drug intended for, but unfit for human consumption as prescribed under this Ordinance, shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of one hundred dollars or imprisonment for one month.
