THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE ACT (CAP. 121)

THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE (EXPORT DUTY RATES FOR ROUND LOGS) (AMENDMENT) ORDER 2010

IN exercise of the powers conferred upon me by Sections 7 of the Customs and Excise Act, I, Gordon Darcy Lilo, Minister of Finance and Treasury, do hereby make the following Order –

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Customs and Excise (Export Duty Rates) (Amendment) Order 2010 and shall be deemed to have commenced on 1st October 2010 and expires on 31st December 2010.
- 2. The export duty payable on the export of round logs shall be calculated and determined in the manner provided in the Schedule herewith.
- 3. The First Schedule to the Customs Act under the heading 44.03 entitled "EXPORT CLASSIFICATION" is amended in the following respects –

DEPORTATION ACT (Cap. 58)

DEPORTATION ORDER - STATEMENT OF FACTS

WHEREAS YOU, RAJAPAKSIIA ARACHILAGE JAYANTHA, are a person who was issued with a resident's permit under section 8(1) of the Immigration Λ ct (Cap. 60) which has now been cancelled by the relevant authorities and therefore you cease to be a holder of a valid residence permit issued under the Λ ct.

AND WHEREAS your continuing presence in the country is contrary to section11(1)(a) and (b) of the Immigration Act and is therefore unlawful.

AND WHEREAS YOU have been declared by the Government as an undesirable person because you have conducted yourself in a manner prejudicial to the peace and public order in Solomon Islands.

AND TAKE NOTICE that the particulars of the facts against you, RAJAPAKSHA ARACHILAGE JAYANTHA or upon which this ORDER is made are as follows –

- 1. That you are a national of Sri-Lanka
- 2. That by virtue of your employment with SOL-LANKA RVT LTD, you were previously issued with a resident permit pursuant to section 8(1) of the Immigration Act, to enter and reside in Solomon Islands.
- 3. That the Director of Immigration has now cancelled your resident permit in conjunction with the facts that you have been terminated by the Management of Sol-Lanka PVT Ltd and currently residing unlawfully in the country, therefore your presence in Solomon Islands is unlawful.
- 4. That after your termination Mr. Nihal Seneviratne, the Director of SOL-LANKA PVT Ltd had arranged your flight on 1st June 2010 to your country of origin but you had escaped from Henderson International Airport and continue to live unlawfully in Solomon Islands.
- 5. That as a result of you being declared an undesirable person under section 11(2)(f) of the Immigration Act, you are hereby issued with this Deportation Order under section 4(b) and (d) of the Deportation Act as read with section 14 of the Immigration Act.

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to section 4 of the *Deportation Act* as read with section 5(1) of the same Act. and having regard to the particulars of facts stated above, I hereby make this Order against you, RAJAPAKSHA ARACHILAGE JAYANTHA, to leave and thereafter to remain out of Solomon Islands.

AND pursuant to section 7(2) of the *Deportation Act*. I hereby authorise that this Order be served on RAJAPAKSHA ARACHILAGE JAYANTHA and to place him on board any ship or aircraft leaving Solomon Islands.

AND I further authorise and direct the Officer-In-Charge of the Honiara Rove Correctional Service or a Police Station in Solomon Islands to detain RAJAPAKSHA ARACHILAGE JAYANTHA until arrangements are completed to place him on board any ship or aircraft.
