FISHERIES ACT 1998

(No. 6 of 1998)

THE FISHERIES (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS 2013

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 25 and 59 of the Fisheries Act 1998, read with Regulation 3 of the Fisheries Regulations 1972, I, ALFRED GHIRO, Minister of Fisheries and Marine Resources, do hereby make the following regulations:

- 1. These Regulations shall be cited as the Fisheries (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations 2013, and shall come into operations on the date of the publication in the *Gazette*.
- 2. The Fisheries (Amendment) Regulations 2005 and Fisheries (Fees) (Amendment) Regulation 2007, is hereby revoked.
- 3. The Fisheries Regulations 1972 is hereby amended by deleting therefrom the Second Schedule and substituting therefor the following new Schedule –
