## LIQUOR ACT (Cap. 144)

## BANNING OF SALE OF LIQUOR (PROVINCIAL ELECTIONS) ORDER 2014

**IN** pursuance of powers conferred on me under section 82(1) of the Liquor Act, I make the following Order:-

- 1. This Order may be cited as the Banning of Sale of Liquor (Provincial Elections) Order 2014.
- 2. For the duration of this Order, no liquor shall be sold from any licensed retail premises, including night clubs and bottle shops, within:
  - a. Central Islands Province;
  - b. Honiara City;
  - c. Isabel Province;
  - d. Guadalcanal Province;
  - e. Malaita Province;
  - f. Rennell and Bellona Province; and
  - g. Temotu Province
- 3. This Order does not apply to the sale or supply of liquor by a hotel to bona fide guests staying in that hotel, or to a restaurant.

- 4. This Order comes into force at 6am on Tuesday 8 December 2014 and expires at 6am on Tuesday 16 December 2014.
- 5. Any person who contravenes this Order commits an offence under the Liquor Act and may also be liable for the revocation, cancellation, or non-renewal of their Liquor Licence.
