LAW REFORM COMMISSION ACT (Cap. 15)

APPOINTMENT OF COMMISSIONERS

I, **Hon. William Bradford Marau**, Minister for Justice and Legal Affairs, under section 4(2) and (4) of the Law Reform Commission Act (Cap.15), appoint the following persons:

DR. ALPHEAUS GRAHAM ZOBULE REUBEN TOVUTOVU

to be Commissioners for a term of four years with effect from the date of publication of this appointment.

The Commissioners are entitled to salaries and allowances specified in the Schedule.

SCHEDULE

- (1) Each Commissioner is entitled to a sitting allowance of \$1,000.00 per day for meetings, workshops, conferences or seminars.
- (2) Each Commissioner is entitled to a subsistence allowance of \$200.00 per day when travelling within Solomon Islands on the Commission's business.

(3) Each part-time Commissioner, at the end of his or her term of appoint ment, must be paid a gratuity of \$15,000.00. In the event of premature termination of the Commissioner's appointment by either party for any reason, other than termination on the ground of misconduct or because the Commissioner has been convicted of any criminal offence, the gratuity will be paid for the portion of period served up to the date of termination.
