SOLOMON ISLANDS INDEPENDENCE ORDER 1978 (LN 43 OF 1978)

ASSIGNMENT OF RESPONSIBILITY TO THE MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND MEDICAL SERVICES

IN exercise of the powers conferred by section 37 of the Constitution and in accordance with the advice of the Prime Minister, I, SIR DAVID VUNAGI, Knight Grand Cross of the Most Distinguished Order of Saint Michael and Saint George, Knight of Grace of the Most Venerable Order of Saint John, Governor-General and Commander-in-Chief of Solomon Islands:

- (a) assign to the person holding the office of MINISTER FOR HEALTH AND MEDICAL SERVICES responsibility for the conduct of the business of the Government of Solomon Islands, including the administration of the Ministry of Health and Medical Services, as set out in the Schedule; and
- (b) revoke the assignment of responsibility to the Minister for Health and Medical Services made on 29 April 2019 and published in *Gazette* No. 71/19.
