EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS 2021 EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (APPOINTMENT OF AUTHORISED OFFICER) (NO. 2) ORDER 2022

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 42(2) of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 3) Regulations 2021*, make the following Order:

1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Appointment of Authorised Officer) (No. 2) Order 2022.*

2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the *Gazette*.

3 Appointment of authorised officers

- (1) Chris Melapi is appointed to be an authorised officer.
- (2) The appointment of the authorised officer has effect only for 15 February 2022.
- (3) The appointment is subject to the conditions and limitations that:
 - (a) the authorised officer's function as an authorised officer is only for the purpose of, facilitating the check in of passengers who are boarding the Solomon Airlines flight from Balalae Airport to Honiara on 15 February 2022.
 - (b) while an authorised officer, he must:
 - (i) wear a face mask: and
 - (ii) practice social distancing; and
 - (iii) wash his hands with soap frequently; and
 - (iv) use hand sanitizer frequently.
