### EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (NO. 3) REGULATIONS 2021

# EMERGENCY POWERS (COVID-19) (HONIARA EMERGENCY ZONE) (RESTRICTION OF MOVEMENT OF PERSONS) (NO. 3) (AMENDMENT) (NO. 4) ORDER 2022

I, Hon. Manasseh Damukana Sogavare, Prime Minister, under regulation 15 of the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (No. 3) Regulations 2021* (Legal Notice No. 318 of 2021), and with reference to sections 36(a) and 65(2) of the *Interpretation and General Provisions Act* (Cap. 85), make the following Order:

#### 1 Citation

This Order may be cited as the *Emergency powers (COVID-19) (Honiara Emergency Zone) (Restriction of Movement of Persons) (No. 3)(Amendment) (No. 4) Order 2022.* 

#### 2 Commencement

This Order commences on the day it is published in the Gazette.

#### 3 Amendment to Legal Notice No. 33 of 2022

This Order amends the *Emergency Powers (COVID-19) (Honiara Emergency Zone)(Restriction of Movement of Persons) Order 2022 (Legal Notice No. 33 of 2022) ("Principal Order").* 

#### 4 Principal order amended

The Principal order is amended by:

- (a) deleting paragraph 4; and
- (b) deleting paragraph 5 and substituting the following:

# **"5** Requirements for persons within the Honiara Emergency Zone

If a person within the Honiara Emergency Zone enter or leaves the Emergency Zone or leaves or is away from his or her place of residence, the person must:

- (a) be vaccinated against COVID-19; and
- (b) have his or her vaccination certificate at all times; and
- (c) wear a face mask; and
- (d) practice social distancing; and
- (e) wash his or her hands frequently; and

(f) use hand sanitizer frequently."
