1. STATEMENT OF SIGNIFICANT ACCOUNTING POLICIES

a) Basis of Accounting

These accounts have been prepared in accordance with the historical cost convention and except where stated do not take into account current valuations of non current assets.

b) Foreign Currency

All amounts are expressed in Australian dollars except for authorised capital which is denominated in Vatu. Transactions in foreign currencies have been translated at the rates ruling at the end of the relevant quarter. Foreign currency amounts outstanding at balance date have been translated to Australian dollars at rates approximating those at 31st December, 1988. All exchange gains and losses, realised or unrealised arising from the conversion of foreign currencies, are dealt with in the profit and loss account.

c) Lease and Hire Purchase Income

Interest has been brought to account on straight line and cash received basis. This is a variation to normal accounting principles, however, this policy has been adopted because it was considered the most prudent and practical method of accounting for the short term (6 to 18 months) type of financing the company normally pursues. Lease and Hire Purchase Debtors are shown in the accounts net of unearned income.

d) Income Tax

The company is incorporated in the Republic of Vanuatu where there is no liability for income tax.
