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LIQUOR LICENSING ACT [CAP. 52]

LIQUOR LICENSING (PROHIBITION OF SALE)

ORDER NO. 20 OF 1996

An order to prohibit the sale and supply of liquor throughout the Republic of Vanautu in the interest of the public, peace and good order during the Provincial Elections.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 19 of the Liquor Licensing Act [CAP. 52], I, ROBERT KARIE, Minister of Home Affairs and Decentralization, hereby make the following Order:

SALE OF LIQUOR THROUGHOUT VANUATU

1. Subject to section 2, the sale, supply and distribution of alcoholic liquor at or on or from Stores and Licensed premises throughout the Republic of Vanuatu whether for consumption on or off the premises is hereby prohibited from 12 o'clock, midday on Saturday 2 November 1996 until half-past seven o'clock in the morning of Tuesday 5 November 1996.

EXCEPTION

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 1, alcoholic liquor may be sold during the said period within the normal hours of opening in restaurants and hotels to bona fide customers for consumption with their meals.

 This Order shall come into force on the 2nd day of November, 1996.

COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY

Pursuant to Article 2(1) of the Agreement Between the Government of the Republic of Vanuatu and the Standdown Vanuatu Mobile Force Members, dated the 12th day of October 1996, I, ROBERT DAVID KARIE, Minister of Home Affairs, make the following proclaimations —

COMMISSION OF ENQUIRY

- (1) The Commission of Enquiry is hereby established consisting of -
 - (a) Magistrate Jerry Boe a member and Chairman;
 - (b) David Schupp a member;
 - (c) Jack Iamlae Kilu a member;
 - (d) Simon Malato a member.
 - (2) The Commission of Enquiry shall -
 - (a) investigate and verify claims by members of the Vanuatu Mobile Force regarding subsistence allowances, cost of living allowances and duty allowances and or allowances payable when members of the Vanuatu Mobile Force are engaged on exercises or duty away from their Camp the subject of the Standdown action taken by members of the Vanuatu Mobile Force;
 - (b) determine the amount in vatu of allowances referred to in paragraph (a) above each member of the Vanuatu Mobile Force is entitled to receive;
 - (c) determine whether the allowances referred to in paragraph (a) were all included in their claims for payment to the Government;
 - (d) enquire into when the claims were lodged initially and subsequently;
 - (e) enquire into the causes for non-payment of all or any of the allowances since 1993;
 - (f) enquire into the conduct of the following officers, Commissioner of Police, Mr Luc Siba, Deputy Commissioner of Police, Mr John Bill, Commander VMF, Mr Patului, Colonel Seule Takal, Finance Officer, Major Mael Apisai and Staff Officer, Pakoa Samuel regarding the non-payment of the allowances and their role in the administration of the affairs of the Vanuatu Mobile Force;

- (g) determine whether there has been any mis-use of funds by Officers within the administration of the Vanuatu Mobile Force;
- (h) produce a report on its enquiry stating clearly its findings and recommendations.

REPORT TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE MINISTER

2. The report containing the findings and recommendations of the Commission of Enquiry shall be submitted to the Minister within such time as to enable its recommendations to be incorporated in the Appropriation legislation for 1997 in accordance with the Agreement. Between the Government and the Standdown Vanuatu Mobile Force Members of 12th October, 1996.

Scope
