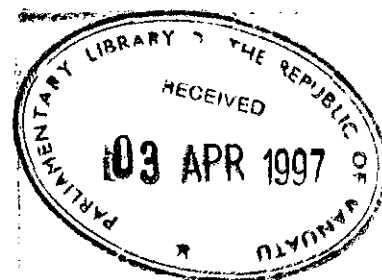

REPRESENTATION OF THE PEOPLE (POLLING DISTRICTS)
(AMENDMENT ORDER NO. 24 OF 1996)

To amend the Representation of the People (Polling Districts) Order No. 16 of 1991.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon the Electoral Commission by sections 4 and 69 of the Representation of the People Act (Cap. 146), the Electoral Commission makes the following Order:-

AMENDMENT OF SCHEDULE TO ORDER NO. 16 OF 1991

1. The Schedule to the Representation of the People (Polling Districts) Order No. 16 of 1991 is amended -
 - (a) in the Efate Constituency in the registration area number 3.01.05 after polling station "C. IFIRA" by adding "D. BLACKSAND";
 - (b) in the Port Vila Constituency by adding the following new Polling Stations:-
 - "G. VILA NORTH SCHOOL
 - H. PAKARO CHURCH
 - I. MUNICIPAL STADIUM.";
 - (c) in the Santo/Malo Constituency:-
 - (i) in the registration area number 1.03.04 by deleting "B. VALPEI" and substituting "E. BETHANY";

(ii) in the registration area number 1.03.04
by adding the following ne Polling
Stations:-

"H. RAVLEPA
I. OLPOE".

COMMENCEMENT

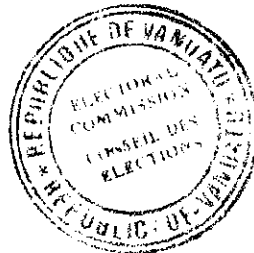

ORDER NO. 9 OF 1997**

To amend the Municipal Council (Elections) (Regulations) Order No. 60 of 1982.

AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 6 OF ORDER NO. 60 OF 1982

1. Regulation 6 of the Municipal Council Elections (Regulation) Order No. 60 of 1982 hereinafter referred to as the "principal Order" is amended –
 - (a) in subregulation (1) -
 - (i) by deleting the words "not less than 14 days" and substituting the words "not less than 4 days";
 - (ii) by deleting the words "within 72 hours" and substituting the words "within 48 hours";
 - (b) in subsection (2) –
 - (i) by deleting the words "not less than 14 days" and substituting the words "not less than 4 days";
 - (ii) by deleting the words "within 72 hours" and substituting the words "within 48 hours".



AMENDMENT OF REGULATION 7

2. Regulation 7 of the principal Order is amended –
 - (i) by deleting the words "for not less than 14 days" and substituting the words "for not less than 4 days";
