# INDEPENDENT AUDITORS' REPORT TO THE MEMBERS OF OBE INSURANCE (VANUATU) LIMITED

#### Scope

We have audited the financial statements of QBE Insurance (Vanuatu) Limited for the financial year ended 30 June 1997 consisting of the profit and loss account, balance sheet, statement of cash flows and accompanying notes set out on pages 2 to 10.
