Workers in this unit group operate machine to excavate, grade, level and compact earth and similar materials, mix concrete and clay road surfaces of asphalt and concrete.

DRIVER Drives motor car or three - wheeled motorised vehicle to transport passengers on demand at a charge based on a fixed tariff.

BUS DRIVER Drives metor-bus to transport local or long distance passengers.

LURRY AND VAN DRIVER Drives vehicle, such as heavy truck, light lorry or delivery van to transport a freight or cargoes over short or long distance. May assist with or perform loading and unloading tasks.
