PLANT PROTECTION ACT NO. 14 OF 1997

PLANT PROTECTION (KAVA EXPORT FEE) ORDER NO. 17 OF 1999

An Order to prescribe the export fee for kava.

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred upon me by section 21(2) of the Plant Protection Act No. 14 of 1997, I, JOHN MORSEN WILLIE, Minister for Agriculture, Livestock, Fisheries and Forestry, hereby make the following Order: -

INTERPRETATION

1. In this Order, unless the context otherwise requires: -

"kava" means natural extracts, dried roots, stumps (chips) and/or basal stems from selected varieties of the plant species Piper methysticum;

"exporter" means a Ni-Vanuatu or a group of Ni-Vanuatu involved in the export of kava.

APPLICATION FOR EXPORT AUTHORITY

- 2. (1) Any person may apply to the Vanuatu Quarantine and Inspection Service for an export authority for the exportation of kava.
 - (2) The Vanuatu Quarantine and Inspection Service may grant or refuse an application made under sub-section (1).

KAVA EXPORT FEE

- 3. (1) The fee payable for the export of kava is thirty thousand vatu (VT30,000) and shall be paid annually before the 31st day of January.
 - (2) Any person applying for an export authority after June of each year shall pay a fee of fifteen thousand vatu (VT15,000).

(3) The fee payable under this section is not refundable.

PERSONS LIABLE FOR PAYMENT OF EXPORT FEE

4. An exporter of kava, dried kava or kava-related products shall pay the fee specified in section 3, to the Vanuatu Quarantine and Inspection Service.
