PORTS ACT CAP 26

Order No.\5 of 2002

To provide for the entry and departure of MV World Discoverer to and from certain ports in Vanuatu.

In exercise of the powers conferred on me by section 2 of the Ports Act [Cap 26], I Jackleen Reuben Titek, Minister responsible for ports and marine, make the following Order:

1 Port of Entry in Vanuatu

The vessel MV World Discoverer is authorized to enter into Vanuatu at the ports of:

- a) Ravenga on Tongoa Island on or about 7 May 2002
- b) Ranon on Ambrym Island on or about 14 may 2002.

2 Ports of Departure from Vanuatu

The vessel MV World Discoverer is authorized to depart from Vanuatu at the following ports:

a) Ikaukau anchorage, Aniwa Island on or about 8 May 2002

b) Loh anchorage in the Torres group of Islands on or about 16 May 2002.

3 Commencement
