## Schedule A

### **Duty Statement**

### Key Responsibilities:

- To develop HR Profile of each Individual working in the Passport Services Office;
- Develop a HRM and HRD structure of the New Passport Service office;
- To develop, process and print all Vanuatu Passport travel documents by transferring from a manual system to an Electronic passport module;
- To facilitate the issuance and cancelling of Vanuatu National Passport travel documents;
- To ensure that the Passport readable machines and consumables are maintained in good functioning order at all times;
- To liaise with relevant authorities such as Immigration, Civil registry, Labour and Citizen office prior to issuing of Vanuatu Passport travel documents to citizens of Vanuatu;
- To comply with the Vanuatu Passport Act and the ICAO standard on the Passport travel documents in ensuring that border control measures are in place;
- To ensure that the Vanuatu Government commits itself to the legal obligations of the Passport Act legislation to ensure that citizens of Vanuatu have a biopage passports for ease of travel around the world;
- To keep Update and Proper Records manually and electronically of all Vanuatu passport travel documents in a proper e-filing sever system and a safe storage file room;
- To disseminate any relevant Information to all border control agencies on the Vanuatu passport travel documents;
- To reports Directly to: Minister for Internal Affairs ;
- To supervise Passport Senior Officer, Passport Research Officer, Database Officer 1, Database Officer 2, receptionist, cleaner and Driver;
- To Communicate frequently with the Minister in relation to the Passport Act and Passport Issuance and cancellations;
- Any other Responsibilities as may be directed by the Minister for Internal Affairs;
