made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa, with
the advice and consent of the Legislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Act, 1921.

Title. 1. This Ordinance may be cited as "The Land for Vaimoso All Purposes Ordinance 1926".

Land taken 2. In pursuance and exercise of the powers and authorities for conferred by clause 271 of "The Samoa Act 1921" and of all other public powers and authorities thereto enabling the pieces of European purpose land described in the schedule hereto are hereby taken for the purposes of the Vaimoso Village and for any other public purpose ancillary thereto.

ALL THOSE pieces or parcels of land situate at the back of the Vaimoso Village, containing one and one-quarter acres (more or less) described as parcels 8 and 13 of Flur 6 District of Tuamasaga and being part of the land registered in the Land Register of Western Samea Volume 1 folio 198.
