HL PREVENTION OF INTIMIDATION ORDINANCE, 1921.

Western Samoa.

No. 1, 1921.

N ORDINANCE

made by the Administrator of the Territory of Western Samoa with the advice and consent of the Vegislative Council of that Territory, and in pursuance of the Samoa Constitution Order, 1920.

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Prevention o Intimidation Ordinance, 1921.

2. Every person commits an offence and on conviction shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding twelve months or to soften not exceeding one hundred pounds who imposes or attempts to impose or who attraites or directs the imposition or attempted imposition upon any other person (whether such authorisation be in respect of a particular person or conscally) of any punishment, fine or penalty or payment in money or foods for having disobsyst any prohibition impress by any person or body of persons against the doing of or obstaining from doing any att which such other person has a legal right to do or abstain from doing.

6. Every person who loiters in the vicinity of any house, shop or other place mentioned in paragraph (c) of section 3 hereof and who after being warned by the owner, occupier, or person in control of such house, shop or other place or by the agent or gorvant of such owner, occupier or person in control or by a constable to desist from sc doing, does not so desist shall, until the contenent is proved, be deemed to have committed the offence set out in the said paragraph.

5. Every person commits an offence and on conviction shall be liable to imprisonment for a term not exceeding six months or to a fine not exceeding £50 who convenes any meeting to discuss the doing of any matter or thing which is an offence under this gradiance or attends at any such meeting while the doing of any such not is discussed.

6. A constable may arrest without warrant any person whom on reasonable grounds he subpects of having committea or attempted to commit any of longe against this Ordinance.
